RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors are to be full time college students
2. All students must have competed in an Intercollegiate Horse Show Association or Varsity Equestrian competition in the Open Division.
3. All Horses and tack will be supplied at the event.
4. Horses will be drawn one hour prior to the class.
5. Exhibitors will be allowed a 5 minute warm up which will be supervised by the horse handler.
6. In the event of a tie:
 - 1- Run off for (for first place only)
 - 2- Use of tie breaker judge
 - 3- Remain tied for placing
7. Rider will be using the NRHA pattern selected prior to the performance.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. The top 4 riders at the 2008 IHSA National Horse Show in the NRHA sponsored Reining will be invited to attend (in the event that any of the top 4 riders can not participate the next highest placing rider will be invited)
2. Four riders will be selected by the Varsity Equestrian Reining Committee.
3. Four riders to be selected based on NRHA accomplishments for the previous 2 years. * In the event of a tie, the IHSA western committee will break the tie by a vote.
